**Thank you for considering registering your child for “Teen Trex Camp”.** Please read this information packet carefully and completely; if you have any questions, notify the Parks and Recreation Office. *Please review the tentative weekly schedule of events. Note that there may be slight changes to this schedule.* **Teen Trex has a minimum number of participants that must register per week, if we do not meet our minimum, we will cancel that week and refunds will be issued.**

**TEEN TREX CAMP FORMAT** Teen Trex is offered in weeklong sessions from Mondays – Thursdays. Our format allows parents to pick and choose which weeks work best for your summer schedule.

The program is offered Mondays-Thursdays, from **8:30am – 4:30pm (end time will vary, view Teen Trex calendar for more accurate timing)**

#### **Teen Trex Fees**

**Teen Trex is offered in weekly sessions**  
**Drop Off/Pick Up Location: Pileggi Park Soccer Clubhouse**  
**4255 Shoemaker Rd Huntingdon Valley**

**\$300 / week for Upper Moreland Residents**

**\$450 / week for non-residents**

Refunds or credits will only be issued in the following instances:

- Requests made 7 days or longer prior to the start of the week a full refund will be issued, provided we do not fall below our weekly minimum.
- Teen Trex has a MINIMUM number of participants needed in order to make the week run. If we do not reach our minimum number, the week will be canceled and refunds will be issued.
- There will be no refunds or credits for illness (missed day or two).
- Injury while participating in the program: pro-rated refund.
- Refunds will not be issued for any child being asked to leave the program for disciplinary reasons.

#### **WHERE AND WHEN DO I DROP OFF AND PICK UP MY CHILD?**

Pileggi Park is located at 4255 Shoemaker Road, Huntingdon Valley. Please check in or have your child check in with the Teen Trex leader upon arrival and departure from the site.

Please note that Teen Trex begins at **8:30 am**. Teen Trex ends between **4:30 pm-6:00 pm**. Parents are asked to be on time for pick-up. Teens arriving early and staying late are the responsibility of the parents.

## **PROCEDURE - LATE PICK UP / EARLY DROP OFF**

Regular days require a 4:30pm pick up. Any time requiring extra supervision will result in a late fee of \$1.00 per minute (per child) beginning at 4:35pm.



The safety of your teen(s) is of the utmost importance. In order to assist our efforts, and to provide the most enjoyable summer experience possible for your child(ren), we ask that you please observe these rules:

1. It is suggested that teens dress appropriately for the weather and the trips that are scheduled. All personal items should be marked with their name.
2. Teen Trex registrants will be participating in a variety of activities daily. Please make sure they have plenty of fluids, sunscreen and necessary items.
3. Pileggi Park is an air-conditioned building and restrooms are on site.
4. We meet regardless of weather. Trips may be postponed or altered due to rain.
5. Communication with the Teen Trex leader will be available when necessary. If you have any questions during the program, please call the Parks and Recreation office at 267-607-1039.
6. Special activities are scheduled during each session. Teens will receive general information concerning all upcoming events (see weekly calendar). Counselors will notify you if there is any additional fee (minimal) for activities they have planned for the day, along with what is sent in the beginning of the week email.
7. Although some of our trips include lunch, parents are encouraged to pack a lunch for their child in a bag clearly marked with the child's name. Please pack items that do not need to be refrigerated. **PLEASE INDICATE ANY ALLERGIES THAT YOUR CHILD MAY HAVE ON THE REGISTRATION FORM. ALSO INFORM YOUR CHILD'S COUNSELOR OF ANY MEDICAL ALERTS.**
8. You may also send extra "spending" money for day trips. Please note that Upper Moreland Parks and Recreation, and Staff are not responsible for lost money or how your child spends it.
9. It is imperative that you stress to your child that they should remain with the group and/or at the facility the entire day. Our responsibility ends when your teen leaves the program site for the day.

### **Teen Trex Behavior Expectations**

All campers are expected to:

1. Communicate with Teen Trex Leaders at designated times (whether that be in-person or via text)

2. Show respect to Teen Trex Leaders, other campers and others that the group comes in contact with.
3. Be Safe - no weapons, alcohol, drugs, vape allowed. No unwanted physical, verbal or electronic contact to Teen Trex Leaders, other campers or the public is acceptable on UMPR trips.
4. Manage their devices - phones are needed for communication on Teen Trex trips. Please be sure all devices are properly charged overnight for trip communication use.

\*If any of these rules are not adhered to, Parents will be contacted.

\*If your child is acting in a manner that is not following Teen Trex Behavior Expectations, UMPR will call and request that you pick your child up from the trip location.

### **DAY TRIP INFORMATION**

We planned many fun and exciting trips and activities for this summer (please see calendar). All trip admissions, supervision, and transportation are included in the price of the program. **Should your teen(s) not wish to attend a specific trip, do not send them that day since all Leaders will be attending the trip.** For example: your teen does not wish to bowl and we have a bowling trip scheduled...they may attend for the day and will be transported to the bowling alley, and may observe or partake in other activities (arcade, snack stand, etc.). If they simply do not wish to go to the bowling alley, do not send them as all Leaders will be attending the trip for safety reasons.

Most days include trips to various destinations. It is important for your child to follow all of the rules and directions that the Teen Trex Leader(s) provides for each trip. This can mean being **on time** when the group is scheduled to depart, and also always staying with at least one other participant. Everyday will be different, but it is important that your child follows the rules daily to help make each trip run smoothly. If there is a delay in returning home we will communicate via email and text blasts.

Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the day's events. **Due to the location of some day trips, return times may run past 4:30pm. Due to trip destination arrival procedures, we cannot hold up the group for late arrivals. We may also depart PRIOR to the 8:30am start time. Please make sure to check the weekly newsletter, AS WELL AS, the calendar of trips. Our Leaders will notify you of these dates.**
