

■ HOT SPOT TOURNAMENT RULES ■

Game Objective:

Players have **1 minute** to score as many points as possible from designated shooting spots on the court.

■ SCORING RULES:

- Each shooting circle has a point value clearly marked on it.
- Both feet must be on the circle when attempting a shot for it to count.
- You may attempt as many shots as needed, but only 3 made layups will count toward your score (no limit on attempts).
- If a player attempts at least one shot from all five spots, they receive a 5-point bonus.
- Each player gets 2 rounds; only the higher of the two scores will count toward tournament standings.

■ SHOOTING SPOTS & POINT VALUES:

- Layup – 1 Point
- 2-Point Spot – Baseline, approximately 8–10 ft from the basket
- 3-Point Spot – Right Elbow
- 4-Point Spot – Left Wing (inside the 3-point line)
- 5-Point Spot – Top of the Key (beyond the 3-point line)

■ WINNING:

The player with the highest single-round score in their division will be crowned **Hot Spot Champion!**
