

Let's All Be Good Sports!

1. Treat all players with courtesy and respect
 - Introduce yourself
 - Don't use foul language or obscene gestures
 - Meet players at the net after each game acknowledging them in a positive way
2. Know the rules of Pickleball
3. Line Calls
 - Respect opponents calls on their side of the court
 - Call your own shot out if you see it is out
 - If you didn't see the shot on your side of the court defer to your opponents and accept their call
 - Don't call balls out unless you see them clearly
 - If you question an opponents call do so respectfully without arguing
 - Resolve uncertainty in favor of your opponents
4. Foot faults
 - Watch your own and your partners feet at the service line and at the NVZ
 - Call them immediately
5. Leave the court between games if there are people waiting
6. Cross behind other courts only when game play has stopped
7. Stray Balls
 - Warn players on other courts of your stray balls
 - Stop play for stray balls on your court
8. Partners
 - Be respectful and supportive
 - Avoid criticism and negative non-verbal communications
